Washington Sea Grant Offers Marine Refrigeration Workshops in Port Townsend

Washington Sea Grant (WSG), Integrated Marine Systems and the Jefferson Education Center are co-sponsoring two one-day Marine Refrigeration Workshops in Port Townsend.

Topics include theory, general maintenance, controller programming, charging with Freon, and thermal expansion valve adjustment. A 7.5-ton refrigeration unit will be used as a training aid during class.

Workshops are scheduled for 10 a.m.-4 p.m. on Saturday, March 14, or Saturday, April 18, at Integrated Marine Systems, 775 Haines Place, Port Townsend. The fee is \$30. Space is limited, so pre-registration is advised.
