NOAA, Washington Sea Grant Offering Two Sessions of Science Camp

Registration is now open for NOAA Science Camp in Seattle this summer. Due to the popularity of the camp, Washington Sea Grant (WSG) and the National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration (NOAA) will offer seventh and eighth graders two chances to explore NOAA science this year — July 6-10 and July 13-17.

The two sessions will offer an array of activities. Campers will spend their days setting up sonar devices and tracking weather balloons, learning about sampling methods, practicing whale identification techniques, reading navigational charts and more.

The fee for either of the five-day NOAA Science Camps is \$250. Scholarships are available.
