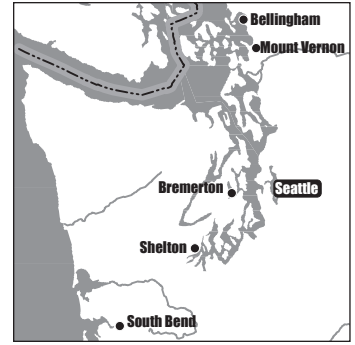


# WASHINGTON SEA GRANT PROGRAM
